About distribution of lottery tickets and numbered event tickets

Lottery tickets (events marked in pink)

- •One lottery ticket per person for each event, distributed at the indicated time and location
- •Line up when lottery begins. There is no need to line up before the scheduled lottery time since selection is not on a first-come, first-served basis
- Each lottery takes about 10 minutes
- Separate lotteries are held for separate events

Numbered event tickets (events marked in blue)

- •One ticket per person will be distributed at the scheduled time and location until capacity is reached.
- Distribution is on a first-come, first-served basis
- Ticket distribution will stop as soon as capacity is reached

Please note that lottery ticket and numbered event ticket distribution times and locations are subject to change depending on Open Day crowds.
